

Russian ethnographer, anthropologist, biologist and traveler who studied the indigenous populations of South-East Asia, Australia and Oceania, including the Papuans of the Northeastern Coast of New Guinea called the Maclay Coast (Rai Coast)

April - May, 2019

The comprehensive research expedition with a team of scientists under the leadership of N.N. Miklukho-Maclay, for the first time accompained by the TV Channel "Russia 24" ("International Observation").

September 11 – October 8, 2017

The expedition led by N.N. Miklouho-Maclay visited the North-East coast of the New Guinea Island and Australia.

September 20, 1871

Researcher N.N. Miklukho-Maclay landed on the North-East coast of the New Guinea Island for the first time.

Meeting with business communities, "Grand Papua" Hotel, Port Moresby. Joint activities with the Russian Ambassador to Papua New Guinea




